1. **District Simplified Grant (DSG)**

- Funds returned back to district, based on the amount of contributions made to RI, DSG are limited to 20% of amount rec'd
- Support short-term service activities, locally or internationally

- review Criteria and Guidelines and Application
- Applications accepted between January 1st and March 31st
- Grants are awarded for the next operating year beginning July 1st
- Clubs that regularly donate to the Rotary Foundation will be given greater consideration to their grant requests
- Approved 8 of the 10 requests rec'd for 2010-2011 period:
 - Food Backpacks, Bicycle Safety Helmets, Backpacks filled with School Supplies, Summer Food Boxes, HIV/Aids Test Kits, Lighting for Veterans Memorial Park, Supplies for At-Risk Students, Picnic Grove
- \$16,628.00 in grant funds were available for 2010-2011
- \$12,227.00 in grant funds are expected to be available for 2011-2012

2. **Matching Grants**

- provides matching funds for international service projects
- enables clubs in one part of the world to connect with a club in another part of the world
- Trustees approved \$21.5 million for 2010-2011
- \$19,834.00 District's Matching Grants Allocation for 2010-2011
- \$15,000.00 District's Matching Grants Allocation for 2011-2012
- Examples of past/current projects: Medical Supplies (Nigeria), Safe Water (Haiti), Prosthetics (India)

3. **Global Grants**

- Health, Hunger and Humanity (3-H) Grants
- fund large-scale, two to four year self-help grassroots development projects
