



Rotary Heroes 2011

A Suggested Timeline:

By January 31st (at your January Board Meeting)

- Explain the process to the club board and get their approval and participation

By February 28th:

- Develop a Rotary Heroes selection process. Depending upon the size of your club, you might consider one of the following alternatives:
 - Take nominations from the club and select your hero by club vote
 - Use a selection committee
 - Have your club board make the selection
 - Some combination of the above

By March 31st:

- Select your club's Rotary Hero
- Email chairperson with the Rotary Hero's name and contact info
- Find or take photos of your Rotary Hero in action

By April 20th (firm date due to printing schedule)

- Email (or mail) to the chairperson
 1. any photos of your Rotary Hero in action
 2. a two word descriptor for your Rotary Hero, for example: "John Smith – An Inspiration", "Mary Jones – Tireless Organizer"
 3. a paragraph or two (not to exceed 125 words) for insertion in the Rotary Heroes' Dinner program describing what makes your honoree a Rotary Hero

Other Important Information:

We ask that your club's Rotary Hero attend the dinner at the District Conference in Lansing to be honored. And we hope the rest of your club will come along to support your Rotary Hero! The club should pay for the dinner for the Rotary Hero, as well as for any guests they may ask to bring.

Club Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs):

What is a Rotary Hero?

Our District 6360 is honoring one member from each club as a Rotary Hero at the District Conference June 3-5, 2011.

Who would be a good Rotary Hero from our club?

Surely your club is full of Rotary Heroes; the problem will probably be to choose a single Rotarian! "Service Above Self" is a good start. Perhaps one of your members has recently outdone themselves. Maybe you would like to honor a senior member's many years of service. Our only requirement is that your honoree be a Rotarian.

How will our Rotary Hero be honored?

District 6360 Rotary Heroes will be honored at the District Conference Rotary Heroes' dinner at 7:00 in the evening. Soon we will notify you whether this will be on Friday or Saturday evening. Each Rotary Hero will be presented with a gift at the podium; the printed program will list each Rotary Hero with a short description written by your club.
